Pet beds can be any size or shape from eighteen inches square for cats and small dogs; up to five feet square for large dogs. They can be sewn with cotton, flannel or fleece material. Use either cotton or polyester batting.

The pillowcase is a purr-fect size!

Please come by our table at the January meeting and pick up a few pet bed kits to take home and practice our quilting skills.

Our goal for 2018 will be 250 pet beds. We can do it!
