We enjoy seeing your creativity and talent! All quilt entries received will then be donated to local NICU's during that season. Challenge quilt entries are as follows:

Easter Theme – due at March 21<sup>st</sup> day meeting 4<sup>th</sup> of July Theme – due June 20<sup>th</sup> day meeting Halloween Theme – due September 19<sup>th</sup> day meeting Christmas – due November 21<sup>st</sup> day meeting

Size of the quilt should be 32" x 32", cotton only, no flannel. Each quilt should have the CPQ label sewn on. You may obtain labels from Patty Ruettgers at the isolette table at the meetings.
