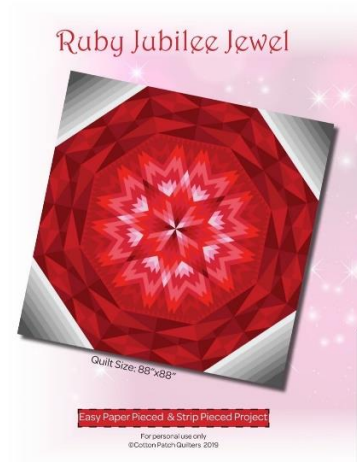

I sure appreciate our members each month who so generously provide goodies for our meetings! MUAH!



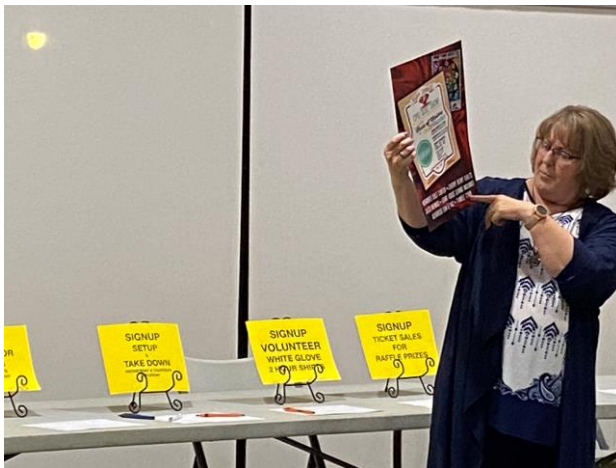
